

Effective: between 22:00 UTC 06th May - 21:59 UTC 31st May 2026.

1. Introduction

The 2026 UEFA Champions League Final - UCLF 2026 will be played at the Puskás Aréna in Budapest, Hungary on 30 May 2026.

The objective of this procedure is to implement a set of rules and procedures in order to:

- Maintain the usual traffic at the airport;
- Process the additional planned traffic specific to the tournament;
- Inform all aircraft operators about the specific rules applicable on the airport and about the enforcement procedure.

2. Operational procedures for UEFA event related flights

- 2.1. Due to the foreseen lack of parking stands, maximum aircraft size is ICAO code C.
- 2.2. Airport will not be available as alternate airport with destination/origin other than BUD/LHBP (including flights declaring distress or emergency).
- 2.3. General/business aviation flights shall prefer positioning flights to neighbouring airports for long term parking after dropping off their passengers at LHBP.
- 2.4. Operators shall plan their operation with Minimum Ground Time (defined for the aircraft type).
- 2.5. If necessary, charter/GA flights will be repositioned from drop-off parking positions to the non-ordinary long term parking positions at Terminal 1 or on Runway 13R/31L by self-maneuvring until the handover point on the runway, and then will be towed for permanent parking. Ground handling agents shall confirm the availability of the pushback and towing equipment for each aircraft type. In case ground handler not able to provide proper towing equipment, aircraft operator shall bring towbar on board.
- 2.6. Crew/technician shall be present after arrival and at least 3 hours prior to departure, as aircraft repositioning might be necessary. Flight crew duty time shall be planned accordingly.
- 2.7. Aircraft should arrive with adequate amount of fuel for the outbound flight, also considering fuel for ground movements. However, when fuelling is necessary, it shall happen in the parking zones, with the crew/technician present.
- 2.8. APU shall be serviceable.
- 2.9. Parking stand and on-time ground handling may not be ensured for flights operating at significantly different time (more than 30 minutes) from their confirmed airport slot.
- 2.10. Departing flights shall depart within 10 minutes of airport slot;
- 2.11. Cleaning / catering / waste / water / toilet service shall be provided upon arrival. Location subject of operational decision;
- 2.12. All charges/fees shall be settled in advance (airport/ground handling fees, taxes etc.)
 - 2.12.1. contact for airport fees can be found in para 6 ("Contact information"),
 - 2.12.2. airport fees shall be settled 3 working days prior operation, see Tariff Manual of Budapest Airport (https://www.bud.hu/en/tariff_manual)
 - 2.12.3. for airport fee calculation, all data shall be provided as described in the Tariff Manual.

- 2.13. Before applying for airport slot, operators are subject to prior permission of the CAA in the case that the aircraft is registered in a State which is not a Contracting Party to the Convention on International Civil Aviation (Chicago Convention) or no bilateral Air Services Agreement has been signed between this State and Hungary. Applications for such flight operations shall be submitted at least 5 days prior to the planned departure to the CAA (see Hungarian AIP GEN 1.2).

3. Passenger procedures for UEFA event related, dedicated flights

- 3.1. Arriving passengers shall have valid travel documents (including VISA if applicable);
- 3.2. Passengers are not allowed to have checked-in baggage. Departure passengers shall have a digital or pre-printed boarding cards. Confirmation required from the Ground handler if they are able to setup the flight in their DCS with correct flight number;
- 3.3. Boarding pass samples shall be provided by the airline in advance to Budapest Airport;
- 3.4. Passengers travelling with dedicated charter flights (ensured all passengers have match tickets) will get bus transportation from the airport to the Fan Meeting Points and back.

4. Airport PPR and slot coordination related procedures

This is a temporary procedure for Liszt Ferenc International Airport during UEFA Champions League Final. Applicable between 22:00 UTC 6 May - 21:59 UTC 31 May 2026.

BUD/LHBP will be slot coordinated (Level 3) on days of 29 May, 30 May and 31 May 2026.

Scheduled, non-scheduled, Business or General Aviation departing from or arriving to the airport during UCLF 2026, will require an airport slot allocated by the coordinator prior to the operation and prior to filling the corresponding ATC flight plan.

Cargo operations (IATA service type: F, M, H, A) will be suspended between 02:00 UTC 30 May and 10:00 UTC 31 May 2026. During this period no cargo flights can be parked or operated to/from BUD/LHBP.

Military operations (IATA service type: W) will be suspended between 22:00 UTC 28 May and 21:59 UTC 31 May 2026. During this period no military flights can be parked or operated to/from BUD/LHBP.

Technical landings, test and training flights (IATA service type: X, T, K) will be suspended between 22:00 UTC 28 May and 21:59 UTC 31 May 2026. During this period no technical flights (fuelling) can be operated to/from BUD.

Fan charter flights with planned arrival time earlier than 09:30 UTC 30 May 2026 shall depart as Ferry/Positioning flights to other airport within 30 minutes.

Returning Ferry/Position flights departing as fan charter flights shall arrive not later than STD-3 hours.

4.1. Night restriction

Night restriction is in force between 20:00-04:00 UTC.

- Budapest Airport is open 24 hours a day, however there is a restriction on the number of movements allowed during the night:
 - between 20:00 and 04:00 UTC maximum 50 movements,
 - within which between 22:00 and 03:00 UTC maximum 6 movements can be planned.
- Aircraft operators planning to operate flights during this period might be exempted from night restriction and therefore must apply in advance for a special permission.
- Operator has to apply for this special permission directly to the CAA. An Operator can request permits for multiple flights in one application, see para 5 for details.

First, special permission shall be requested from the CAA after 6 May 22:00 UTC. Requests submitted previously shall be rejected on the grounds of being premature. Then, PPR confirmation shall be obtained (see section 4.2). The CAA evaluates the request for night operation in parallel with the PPR reviewing process. Applications for such flight operations shall be submitted to the CAA no later than 5 days before the planned date of the flight. Expect confirmations both for night exemption and PPR from 06:00 UTC 13 May. Finally, an airport slot shall be requested from the Coordinator. Slot allotment will only take place based on the previously issued special permissions. Slot requests filed without valid CAA permission and PPR number will be rejected by the Coordinator.

Please do not copy the Coordinator when requesting special permission from CAA.

Please be informed that currently all night quotas have been already allocated for scheduled flights between 20:00 - 04:00 UTC.

4.2. PPR management during UCLF 2026

Due to limited stand availability Prior Permission Request (PPR) procedure will be applied to all operations, except IATA service type „J”. These requests shall be approved in advance by the Airport Managing Body. PPR shall be sent via the <https://www.bud.hu/en/prior-permission-request-uefa-2026> website for all individual flight pair. Only after receiving confirmation from ppr@bud.hu, slot request can be sent to Coordinator with PPR number.

Please note: event operations priorities will be taken into account during the PPR process.

PPR does not adhere to conditions described in point 4. will be rejected.

Expect PPR confirmation/offer/rejection from 06:00 UTC 13 May except the rejection described in the previous point.

Once you have submitted your PPR, do not send a new application or modification for your previously requested flight until you have received answer („Prior Permission Request - confirmation/offer”), otherwise these will be rejected.

Only the early cancellations can be sent by the operator before the deadline described above answering the „Prior Permission Request - acknowledged” message received from ppr@bud.hu.

After receiving an answer about confirmation/offer from ppr@bud.hu, any PPR not intended to be used shall be cancelled by the operator by replying to the email „Prior Permission Request - confirmation/offer”.

PPR changes / cancellations shall include the original PPR confirmation number (if applicable).

Requests received after 06:00 UTC 13 May are subject to the remaining capacity left over by earlier requests.

The following flights are exempted from PPR and slot allocation but we highly recommend that the operators keep BUD informed of their intention even at short notice:

- Medical, evacuation or humanitarian flights;
- State flights;
- Search and rescue operations.

Next specific paragraphs will be applicable for flights:

1. which are operating on the affected date (arrival and/or departure);
2. for which the aircraft is intended to stay at the airport over one of the affected date;
3. possessing PPR confirmation with reference number.

4.3. Slots requests

Having PPR and CAA confirmation, request for airport slot can be submitted: slot allocation during PPR phase will only take place based on beforehand approved PPR, slot request filled without valid PPR number will be rejected by Coordinator.

All slot requests must include the PPR number in the Reference line, after “/”.

Please do not copy the Coordinator when requesting PPR.

Air carriers who will operate flights to and from Budapest Liszt Ferenc International Airport for the UCLF 2026 on days of 29 May, 30 May and 31 May 2026, shall follow the following schedules coordination procedures:

1. The Event Slot Clearance Requests and General Clearance Request (SCR and GCR) collection will start at 13 May 06:00 UTC, will end at 21:59 UTC 17 May 2026.
2. Slot requests for charter flights must be sent in SCR format to:
budcoord@budcoord.hu
3. In case of any SSIM (Standard Schedules Information Manual) error, the message will be returned for correction.
4. Slots requests must be submitted with turnaround information, either with 2 single legs in one SCR or in a turnaround format (except flights using existing aircraft based at the airport), and shall contain PPR reference number in REF line after “/”.
5. Due to limited parking stands availability the ground time should be reduced to an absolute necessary minimum.
6. In order to identify requests specific for the UCLF 2026 among all other requests, operators must use the following service type codes (STC) for these flights:
 - use of service type code „O” for any flight with UEFA team and team family charter;
 - use of service type code „Y” for any flight with supporter and passenger Team A (Team A will be designated and published on the coordinator’s website once the two finalist teams are known - May 7, 2026)
 - use of service type code „Z” for any flight with supporter and passenger Team B

(Team B will be designated and published on the coordinator's website once the two finalist teams are known - May 7, 2026)

- use of service type „P” for any positioning flight
- use of any combination (i.e. O-O, O-P, P-O etc.) for the turnaround format

NOTE: these service type codes shall be used only for flights specific to the Final.

7. Slots for General and Business Aviation flights shall be requested by the operator in GCR format (explanation at: [GCR-INT \(fluko.org\)](https://fluko.org)). In order to identify requests specific to the Final among all other GA/BA requests, operators must use the following service type code for these flights:

- use of service type code „N” for General and Business Aviation flights with relation to the Final

If above mentioned information will not be provided in SI, slot request will be rejected.

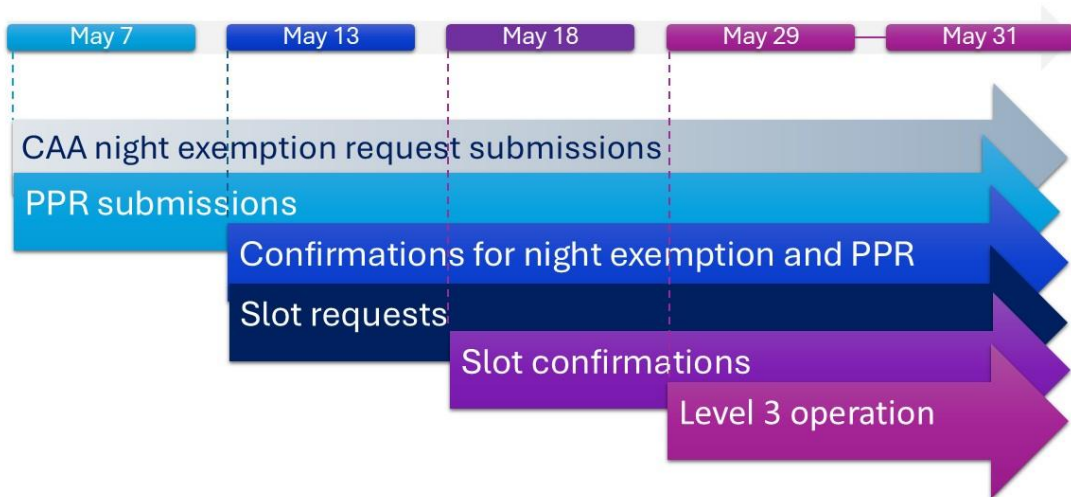
4.4. APPLICATION AND ALLOCATION TIMELINE

Application for flights to the football Champions League Final in Budapest will only be accepted once final match opponents are known (07 May 2026, start of business).

Once you have submitted your slot request, do not send a new application, cancellation, or modification for your previously requested flight until you have received confirmation, otherwise these will be rejected!

Requests received after the above deadline date shall be subject to the remaining capacity left over by earlier requests.

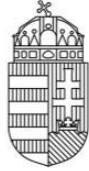

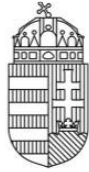
